Aug 18 John 3:14-15

14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, **15** that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

Aug 25 John 3:16

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Sep 1 John 3:17

17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

Sept 8 John 3:18

18 "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Sept 15 John 3:19

19 And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

Sept 22 Psalm 34:8-9

Sept 29 Psalm 34:10

10 The young lions lack and suffer hunger;

Oct 6 Psalm 34:11

11 Come, you children, listen to me;
I will teach you the fear of the Lord.

Oct 13 Psalm 34:12-13

12 Who is the man who desires life,
And loves many days, that he may see good?
13 Keep your tongue from evil,
And your lips from speaking deceit.

Oct 20 Proverbs 3:5-6

5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart,
And lean not on your own understanding;

6 In all your ways acknowledge Him,
And He shall direct your paths.

Oct 27 Romans 10:9

9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Nov 3 Psalm 23:1-3

1 The Lord *is* my shepherd; I shall not want.

2 He makes me to lie down in green pastures;
He leads me beside the still waters.

3 He restores my soul;
He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.

Nov 10 Psalm 23:4

4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death,
I will fear no evil;
For you are with me;
Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

Nov 17 Psalm 23:5

5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies;
You anoint my head with oil;
My cup runs over.

Dec 1 Psalm 23:6

6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me
All the days of my life;
And I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Dec 8 Matthew 18:1-3

1 At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who then is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?"

2 Then Jesus called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them, **3** and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.

Dec 15 Matthew 18:4-5

4 Therefore whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

5 Whoever receives one little child like this in My name receives Me.

Jan 5 Matthew 18:6

6 "But whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to sin, it would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

Jan 12 The Ten Commandments - Exodus 20:3-5a

3 "You shall have no other gods before Me.

4 "You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of *anything* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth;

Jan 19 The Ten Commandments - Exodus 20:7-8

5 you shall not bow down to them nor serve them.

7 "You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold *him* guiltless who takes His name in vain.

8 "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Jan 26 The Ten Commandments - Exodus 20:12-17

13 "You shall not murder.

15 "You shall not steal.

Feb 2 Matthew 11:28

16 "You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.

Feb 9 Matthew 11:28

28 Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

Feb 16 Matthew 11:29-30

29 Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am ^lgentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

30 For My yoke *is* easy and My burden *is* light."

Feb 23 Matthew 22:36-39

36 "Teacher, which *is* the great commandment in the law?"

37 Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.'

38 This is *the* first and great commandment.

39 And *the* second *is* like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.'
