**9** If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

**Aug 27      John 1:2**

**12** But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name:

**Sept 3      Romans 6:23**

**23** For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

**35** For whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.

**Nov 5      Mark 8:36-37**

**36** For what shall it profit a man, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul?

**37** Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

**Nov 12      Mark 8:38**

**38** Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels.

**Nov 19      1 Peter 5:8**

**8** Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:

**15** As the Father knoweth me, even so know I the Father: and I lay down my life for the sheep.

**Jan 21      Matthew 9:38**

**38** Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

**Jan 28      John 8:31-32**

**31** Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;

**32** And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

**Feb 4      Romans 8:28**

**28** And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

**Feb 11      Ephesians 4:31-32**

**31** Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice:

**20** But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

**Mar 4            Romans 12:1-2**

**1** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

**2** And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

**Mar 18           Romans 12:3-5**

**3** For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

**4** For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office:

**5** So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

**Mar 25           Romans 12:6-8**

**6** Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith;

**7** Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching;

**8** Or he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that sheweth mercy, with cheerfulness.

**April 1           Romans 12:9-11**

**9** Let love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good. **10** Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honour preferring one another; **11** Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord;

**April 22      Romans 12:12-15**

**12** Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer;

**13** Distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality.

**14** Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not.

**15** Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep.

**April 29      Romans 12:16**

**16** Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

**May 6          Romans 12:17-19**

**17** Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men.

**18** If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

**19** Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

**May 13        Romans 12:20-21**

**20** Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

**21** Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
