Aug 12	Genesis 1:1	In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.
Aug 19	Genesis 1:2	And the earth was without form and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.
Aug 26	Genesis 1:3-4	And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness.
Sept 2	Genesis 1:5	And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day.
Sept 9	John 14:1-2	Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
Sept 16	John 14:3-4	And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.
Sept 23	John 14:5	Thomas said unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?
Sept 30	John 14:6	Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

Oct 7	Matthew 5:1-2	And seeing the multitudes, he went up into a mountain: and when he was set, his disciples came unto him: And he opened his mouth, and taught them, saying,
Oct 14	Matthew 5:3-4	Blessed are the poor in spirit: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are they that mourn: for they shall be comforted.
Oct 21	Matthew 5:5-6	Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled.
Oct 28	Matthew 5:7-8	Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.
Nov 4	Matthew 5:9-10	Blessed are the peacemakers: for they shall be called the children of God. Blessed are they which are persecuted for righteousness' sake: for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
Nov 12	Matthew 5:11	Blessed are ye, when men shall revile you, and persecute you, and shall say all manner of evil against you falsely, for my sake.
Nov 18	Luke 2:8-9	And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid.
Dec 2	Luke 2:10-11	And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.
Dec 9	Luke 2:13	And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,
Dec 16	Luke 2:14	Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

Jan 6	Psalms 1:1-2	Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.
Jan 13	Psalms 1:3	And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
Jan 20	Psalms 1:5-6	Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
Jan 27	Psalms 24:1-2	The earth is the LORD's, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.
Feb 3	Psalms 24:3-4	Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place? He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.
Feb 10	Psalms 24:5-6	He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation. This is the generation of them that seek him, that seek thy face, O Jacob. Selah.
Feb 17	Psalms 24:7-8	Lift up your heads, O ye gates; and be ye lift up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.
Feb 24	Psalms 24:9-10	Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The LORD of hosts, he is the King of glory. Selah.
Mar 3	Matthew 5:13	Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.
Mar 10	Matthew 5:14-15	Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.

Mar 24	Matthew 5:16	Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
Mar 31	Hebrews 11:1-2	Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report.
Apr 7	Hebrews 11:3	Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.
Apr 14	Hebrews 11:4	By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.
Apr 21	Hebrews 11:5	By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.
Apr 28	Hebrews 11:6	But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
May 5	Proverbs 3:5-6	Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
