Various verses from the Gospel of John—NKJV

Aug 18 John 1:1-3

[1](#) In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

[2](#) He was in the beginning with God.

[3](#) All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

Aug 25 John 1:4-5, 10

[4](#) In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

[5](#) And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

[10](#) He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

Sep 1 John 1:11-13

[11](#) He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

[12](#) But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

[13](#) who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

Sep 8 John 1:14-15, 17

[14](#) And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

[15](#) John bore witness of Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me is preferred before me, for He was before me.' "

[17](#) For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

Scripture Memory 2022-2023

Sep 15 John 3:5-7

[5](#) Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

[6](#) That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

[7](#) Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.'

Sep 22 John 3:16-18

[16](#) For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

[17](#) For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

[18](#) He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Sep 29 John 4:23-26

[23](#) But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him.

[24](#) God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

[25](#) The woman said to Him, "I know that Messiah is coming" (who is called Christ). "When He comes, He will tell us all things."

[26](#) Jesus said to her, "I who speak to you am He."

Oct 6 John 5:19-20

[19](#) Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.

[20](#) For the Father loves the Son, and shows Him all things that He Himself does; and He will show Him greater works than these, that you may marvel.

Scripture Memory 2022-2023

Oct 13 John 6:27-29

[27](#) Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him."

[28](#) Then they said to Him, "What shall we do, that we may work the works of God?"

[29](#) Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He sent."

Oct 20 John 7:37-39

[37](#) On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.

[38](#) He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water."

[39](#) But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Oct 27 John 10:9-11

[9](#) I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.

[10](#) The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

[11](#) I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep.

Nov 3 John 10:27-30

[27](#) My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.

[28](#) And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.

[29](#) My Father, who has given them to Me, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch them out of My Father's hand.

[30](#) I and My Father are one."

Scripture Memory 2022-2023

Nov 10 John 12:24-26

[24](#) Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.

[25](#) He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.

[26](#) If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him My Father will honor.

Nov 17 John 13:3-5

[3](#) Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God,

[4](#) rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself.

[5](#) After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded.

Dec 1 John 13:31,34-35

[31](#) So, when he had gone out, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man is glorified, and God is glorified in Him.

[34](#) A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

[35](#) By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

Dec 8 John 14:1-3

[1](#) "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me.

[2](#) In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

[3](#) And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.

Dec15 John 14:4-6

[4](#) And where I go you know, and the way you know."

[5](#) Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can we know the way?"

[6](#) Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

Jan 5 John 14:12-14

[12](#) "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

[13](#) And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

[14](#) If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

Jan 12 John 14:15-18

[15](#) "If you love Me, keep My commandments.

[16](#) And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever--

[17](#) the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

[18](#) I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.

Jan 19 John 14:23-24

[23](#) Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.

[24](#) He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me.

Jan 26 John 14:25-27

[25](#) "These things I have spoken to you while being present with you.

[26](#) But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

[27](#) Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Feb 2 John 15:1-3

[1](#) "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.

[2](#) Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit.

[3](#) You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you.

Feb 9 John 15:4-5

[4](#) Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

[5](#) I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

Feb 16 John 15:6-8

[6](#) If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.

[7](#) If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

[8](#) By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

Scripture Memory 2022-2023

Feb 23 John 16:8-11

[8](#) And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment:

[9](#) of sin, because they do not believe in Me;

[10](#) of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more;

[11](#) of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

Mar 2 John 17:20-21

[20](#) "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word;

[21](#) that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.

Mar 9 John 18:4-6

[4](#) Jesus therefore, knowing all things that would come upon Him, went forward and said to them, "Whom are you seeking?"

[5](#) They answered Him, "Jesus of Nazareth." Jesus said to them, "I am He." And Judas, who betrayed Him, also stood with them.

[6](#) Now when He said to them, "I am He," they drew back and fell to the ground.

Mar 23 John 18:36-37

[36](#) Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not of this world. If My kingdom were of this world, My servants would fight, so that I should not be delivered to the Jews; but now My kingdom is not from here."

[37](#) Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth..."

Mar 30 John 19:1-3

[1](#) So then Pilate took Jesus and scourged Him.

[2](#) And the soldiers twisted a crown of thorns and put it on His head, and they put on Him a purple robe.

[3](#) Then they said, "Hail, King of the Jews!" And they struck Him with their hands.

Apr 6 John 19:4-6

[4](#) Pilate then went out again, and said to them, "Behold, I am bringing Him out to you, that you may know that I find no fault in Him."

[5](#) Then Jesus came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. And Pilate said to them, "Behold the Man!"

[6](#) Therefore, when the chief priests and officers saw Him, they cried out, saying, "Crucify Him, crucify Him!" Pilate said to them, "You take Him and crucify Him, for I find no fault in Him."

Apr 13 John 19:7-9

[7](#) The Jews answered him, "We have a law, and according to our law He ought to die, because He made Himself the Son of God."

[8](#) Therefore, when Pilate heard that saying, he was the more afraid,

[9](#) and went again into the Praetorium, and said to Jesus, "Where are You from?" But Jesus gave him no answer.

Apr 20 John 19:10-11

[10](#) Then Pilate said to Him, "Are You not speaking to me? Do You not know that I have power to crucify You, and power to release You?"

[11](#) Jesus answered, "You could have no power at all against Me unless it had been given you from above. Therefore the one who delivered Me to you has the greater sin."

Scripture Memory 2022-2023

Apr 27 John 19:17-19

[17](#) And He, bearing His cross, went out to a place called the Place of a Skull, which is called in Hebrew, Golgotha,

[18](#) where they crucified Him, and two others with Him, one on either side, and Jesus in the center.

[19](#) Now Pilate wrote a title and put it on the cross. And the writing was: JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS.

May 4 John 19:28-30

[28](#) After this, Jesus, knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled, said, "I thirst!"

[29](#) Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there; and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on hyssop, and put it to His mouth.

[30](#) So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

May 11 John 20:19, 21

[19](#) Then, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace be with you."

[21](#) So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

May 18 John 21:24-25

[24](#) This is the disciple who testifies of these things, and wrote these things; and we know that his testimony is true.

[25](#) And there are also many other things that Jesus did, which if they were written one by one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that would be written. Amen.
